# **Course Overview**

This practical short course provides participants with handson skills and technical knowledge in **modern goat production**, from selection and breeding to health and business management.

The course is ideal for **farmers**, **youth entrepreneurs**, **agricultural officers**, and anyone aspiring to invest in profitable goat farming enterprises.

## **Course Modules**

#### 1. Introduction to Goat Production

- Overview of the importance of goats in Zambia's livestock industry.
- Role of goats in income generation and rural livelihoods.

#### 2. Goat Breeds and Selection

- Identification of common local and exotic breeds.
- Criteria for selecting breeding stock for meat and milk production.

#### 3. Goat Nutrition and Feeding
