Modules Covered

1. Introduction to Pig Production

6. Management Practices

Focuses on daily piggery management, weaning, pen sanitation, record-keeping, castration, and grouping strategies for optimum growth.

7. Marketing and Record Keeping

Teaches market assessment, value chain opportunities, grading of pigs, pricing, and maintaining farm records for financial planning and profitability assessment.

8. Waste Management and Environmental Protection

Participants learn manure handling, slurry management, odor control, and environmentally friendly waste disposal systems.
